Pukekohe's Saturday cattle auction saw prices firm on both prime and older store stock, with demand for any short-term cattle on offer. Weaner cattle were a different matter! Small x-bred weaners are very difficult to sell, despite the obvious good buying to be had. Margins between selling big cattle and buying replacements has rarely been better. Grass is good, the weather is kind, and it is very hard to understand the low weaner prices!
